- 3. Testing any existing well for productivity and water quality, or investigating the feasibility of a new well, including cost estimates for location and construction, by a licensed or certified well drilling contractor.

If Buyer does not take action on one or more of these vacant land investigation rights they are doing so against the advice of the Seller, Listing and Selling Agent(s) and Broker(s) in the transaction.

Buyer has not relied upon any representation by the Seller, Listing and Selling Agent(s) or Broker(s) regarding these rights and agrees to release them from any and all costs, claims, expenses, damages, etc. of any kind related to those defects, damages and adverse existing and potential conditions which could be ascertained by any of these vacant land investigations.
